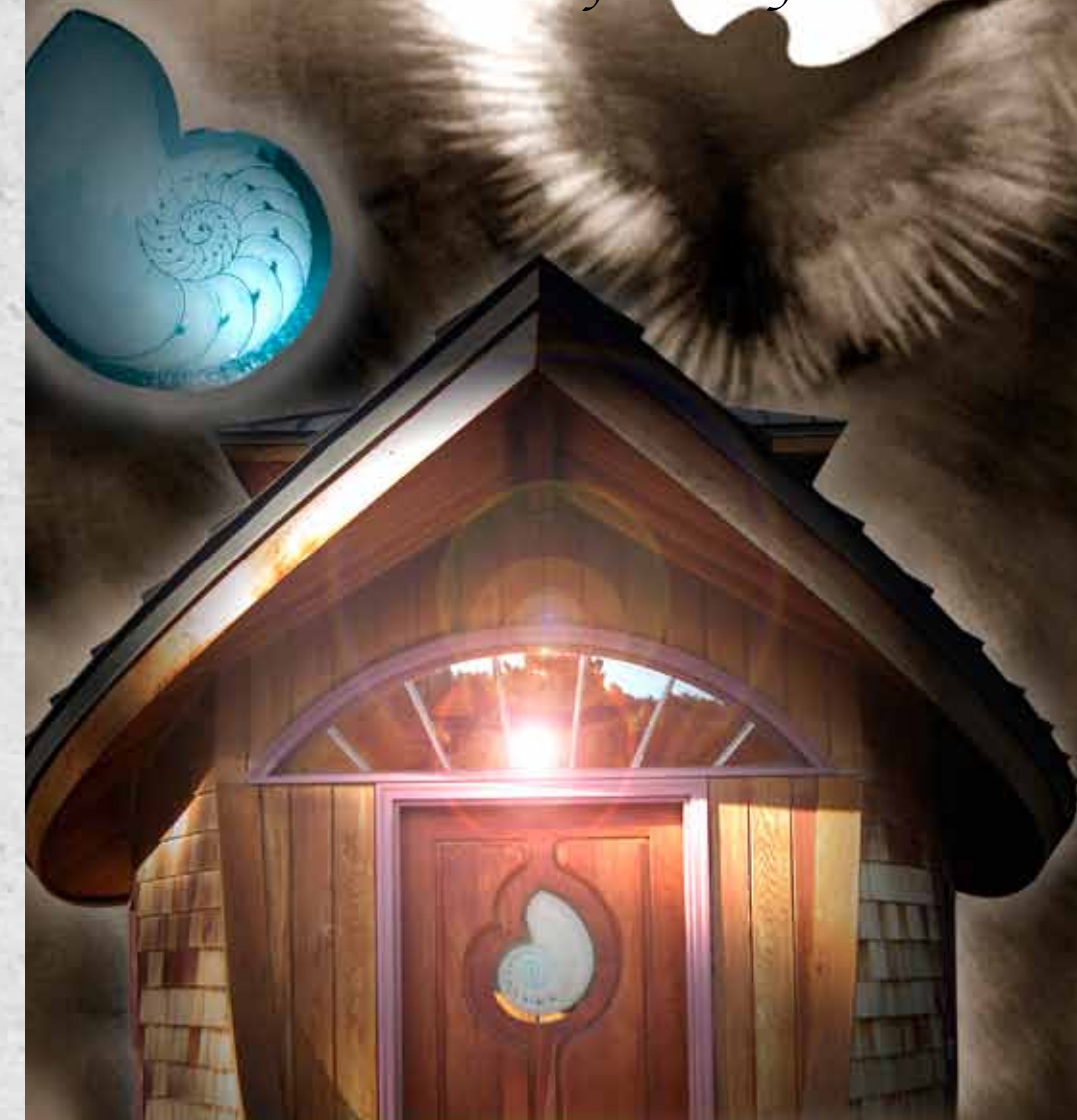

# THE STARHOUSE

ALL SEASONS CHALICE



*All Seasons Chalice provides sacred ground for spiritual and ceremonial practice based on love of the Divine, honor for all beings, earth stewardship, and seasonal and celestial community celebrations.*

## THE EMBRACE OF NATURE:

- The StarHouse is minutes from the bustling city of Boulder, in a vast expanse of calm and quiet at 7000 feet altitude.
- This property is cared for in many ways: it is certified organic; bio-dynamic practices are used on the land; no shooting is allowed; and prayer is practiced here.
- Lean up against one of the grand trees and enjoy the many fanciful shapes and colors in the meadow. Take in the sun radiance of St. John's wort.
- Marvel at lichen-painted rocks sculpted by time, and enjoy the chickadees, eagles and hawks.
- Follow the great inbreath and outbreath of the seasons, from flowers to snow.
- Notice the grand canopy of the sky and the stars that come out when city lights don't interfere.
- Star light, Earth glow, warmth of others' hearts.



## THE STRUCTURES:

- The StarHouse: conceived in 1989, completed in 1990. Twelve-sided – a dodecagon – created from the sacred geometry that was used to design the great cathedrals of Europe. Each grand post given by the surrounding land.
- The WaterHouse: a unique round building for the composting toilets, a place where water is honored by the economy of its use.
- The StarHouse Retreat Cabin: a place to rest and rejuvenate.

## THE SITES:

- The Goddess Grove: a place of meditation with Kwan Yin.
- Mary's Well: the miracle of a well of water in a semi-arid land.
- The Labyrinth: a Cretan-style walking meditation site.
- The PCA Entry Posts: for men and women entering the Path of the Ceremonial Arts program.
- The Old Homestead: built in 1904, when this meadow was farmed, now near the Old Grandfather tree.
- And many other magical sites on this land.



## THE PROGRAMS:

- There are several ongoing programs that have made their home at The StarHouse.
- The Path of the Ceremonial Arts (PCA) – a three-year training in the art of living a sacred life: [www.PathOfTheCeremonialArts.org](http://www.PathOfTheCeremonialArts.org)
- Dances of Universal Peace – regular practices of dance and chant to bring sacred texts more deeply into the body.

- Journey of the Feminine – women explore the archetypes of Feminine Wisdom.

## THE MINISTERS:

- An eclectic, trans-denominational group who support The StarHouse and its community through ritual, ceremony and service.
- Graduates of the PCA program also guide the ceremonies at The StarHouse.



## THE CEREMONIES:

- Celestial and seasonal ceremonies to emphasize the beauty of creation and its rhythms.
- Full Moons and New Moons, each with a particular theme, opportunities to work with the heavens to arouse, strengthen and train one's inner lights.
- Equinoxes – equal day and equal night (March 21 and September 21), a seasonal phenomenon shared by all people on Earth on those days.
- Solstices – longest day (June 21) and longest night (December 21), an opportunity to celebrate light in its fullness and in its absence.
- Cross Quarter celebrations, weddings, baby blessings – all the ways that a community comes together to honor the cycles of the year and the seasons of a life.
